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#### INTRODUCTION

An international conference of states held in Bangkok on 12-16 December 1983 adopted the Regional Convention on the Recognition of Studies, Diplomas and Degrees in Higher Education in Asia and the Pacific. This was the sixth regional convention to be adopted and came in force on 23 October 1985. As of now, twelve Member States: Armenia, Australia, China, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Maldives, Mongolia, Nepal, Republic of Korea, Russian Federation, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, and Turkey have ratified the convention. The convention aims at facilitating mobility of scholars and students across the region through the recognition of degrees, diplomas, certificates and other forms of study for development of higher education.

The aim of this brochure is to facilitate cooperation in matters of academic mobility and recognition of degrees, diplomas and certificates in Asia and the Pacific Region. The brochure provides a list of national information centres for academic recognition of university degrees, diplomas and certificates. Each country has set up a National Development Group (NDG) to identify and support educational innovations for development within the country and facilitate exchange between countries.

Asia-Pacific Centre of Educational Innovation for Development (ACEID), an integral part of the UNESCO Principal Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific in Bangkok, co-ordinates the activities under APEID and assists the Associated Centres (AC) in carrying them out.
