Although we have gathered more information on some institutions and less on others, for consistency reasons, we have standardised the presentation of information.

The **institution name** appears on the top of each page and at the bottom right side of each page there is an indication of when the data on that institution was last updated. The **fields of study** offered are indicated according to the way that they are designated by the particular institution. Here, we have tried to identity institutions in each country with **fields of study** most closely related to home economics, food and nutrition and health sciences. [In some countries, e.g., Burkina Faso, Gambia, Liberia, Senegal, Somalia, the closest **field of study** identified to these areas is public health.] **Student enrolment applies** to the particular Centre, Faculty or Department as specified in the institution entry at the top of each page.

Information on **student enrolment and school fees** were obtained from the references cited above or the institution itself (in this case, the figures apply to the year in which the information was updated by the institution). Invariably, with each new academic year there will be fluctuations. This information should be regarded as indicative.

A number of African countries, we note, are particularly endowed with training programmes in the areas of concern-Nigeria, Egypt, Kenya, United Republic of Tanzania, Malawi and Zambia-and many of these programmes offer degrees at Masters and Doctorate levels.

We were unable to identify relevant institutions in the following countries-Angola, Cape Verde, Comoros, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Mali, Mozambique, Namibia and Sao Tome and Principe.

This compendium has been a collaborative project with the **International Union of Nutritional Sciences** and UNESCO. Dr. **Rajammal P. Devadas**, Vice Chancellor of the Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women (Deemed University), Coimbatore, India, serves as Chairperson of the **RUNS** Committee associated with this effort.
